



Queer Spirit Camp is an engaging leadership program for LGBTQ young adults and their allies ages 18-24 that is entertaining, and empowering. QSC strives to help the participant become more self-aware by creating a safe environment for the expression, and connection of mind, body, heart and spirit. QSC also allows the participant to grow through new experiences and ideas. By planning the event themselves they make choices, act and lead with compassion, integrity, creativity and joy.

Queer Spirit Camp is hosted by Easton Mountain, a spiritual community of men dedicated to transforming and healing the human soul. They are proud to support such an important mission. Easton Mountain is a retreat on 175 acres in upstate New York and welcomes all who seek the wisdom of the body, and the interdependence of all life. The participant is charged \$30 for the entire week and Easton Mountain fundraises for the balance of the cost so income is not a barrier to participation.

Because Queer Spirit Camp is open to approximately 60 participants for six days it is important to have professionals become an integral part of the week. This includes facilitating a workshop, leading small group support sessions and/or talking one on one with a youth in need. Our participants come from all socio-economic backgrounds and require different levels of support. This is why the lead facilitators have agreed that professional social workers, educators and other trained and experienced youth workers are imperative to make this program a success.
